The AYC is a member of the Yachting Club of America, which publishes the Register of American Yacht Clubs. This Register contains the names of over 700 Yacht and Sailing Clubs that offer reciprocity.

You may visit YCA's website at www.ycaol.com. To access the Club listing on their website, you will need to enter our user ID "club1040" (case sensitive) and a password. The password is located on your Membership Card. If you do not already have a 2018 Membership Card, they are available behind the bar. A picture of the card is shown above. You may also view a hard copy of the Register, which is maintained by Norma.



Here are several suggestions for usage of Reciprocal Clubs:

- 1) Contact the Club that you plan to visit in advance. In prior years, a few Clubs have required a letter of introduction. Norma can provide this letter.
- 2) You may be requested to show both your current AYC and YCA Membership Cards at the time of your visit.
- 3) We request that all charges for food and beverage be paid at the time of service (if permitted).
